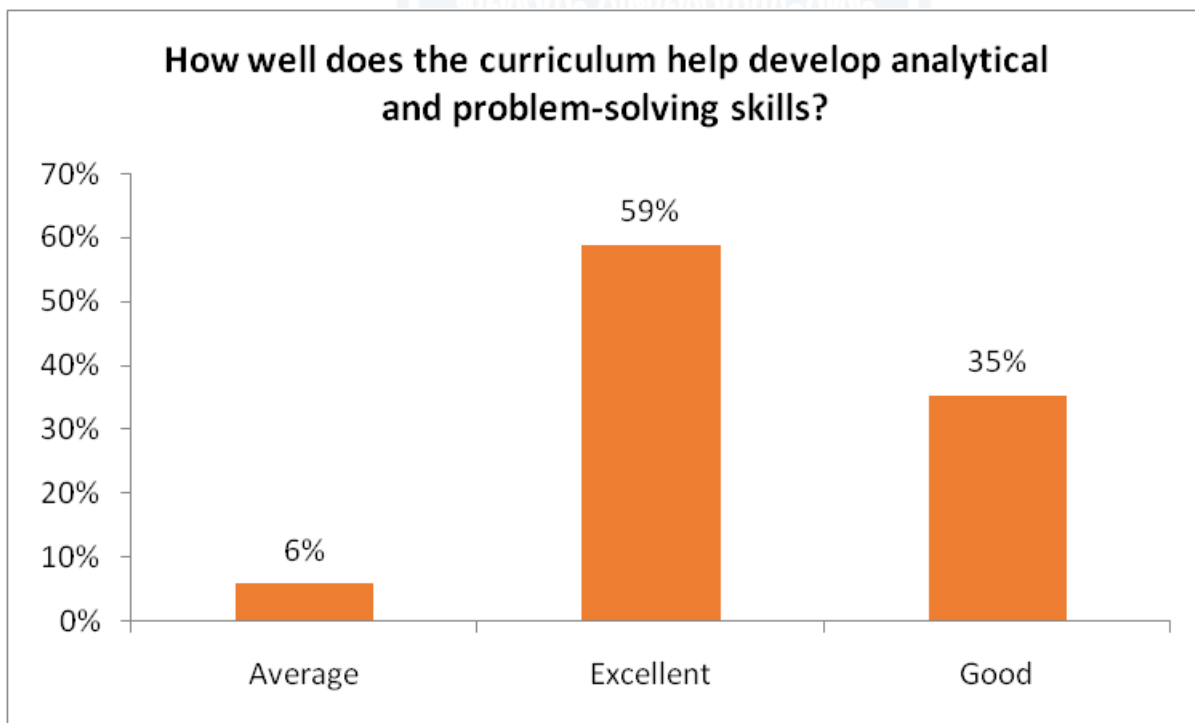

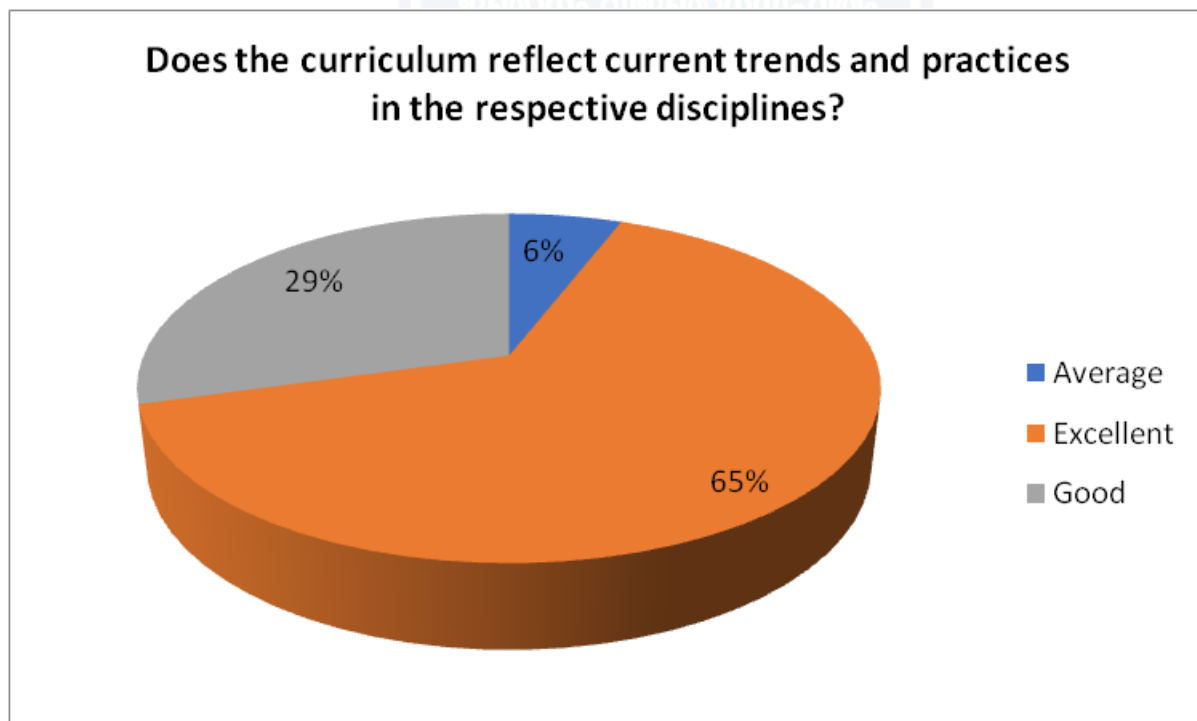

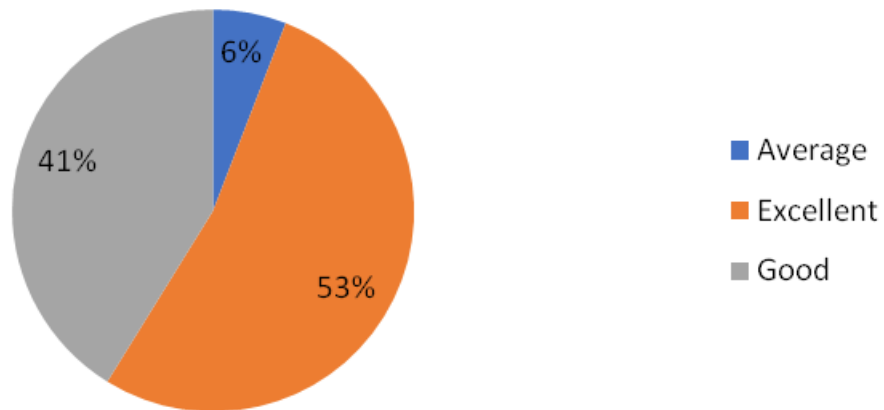

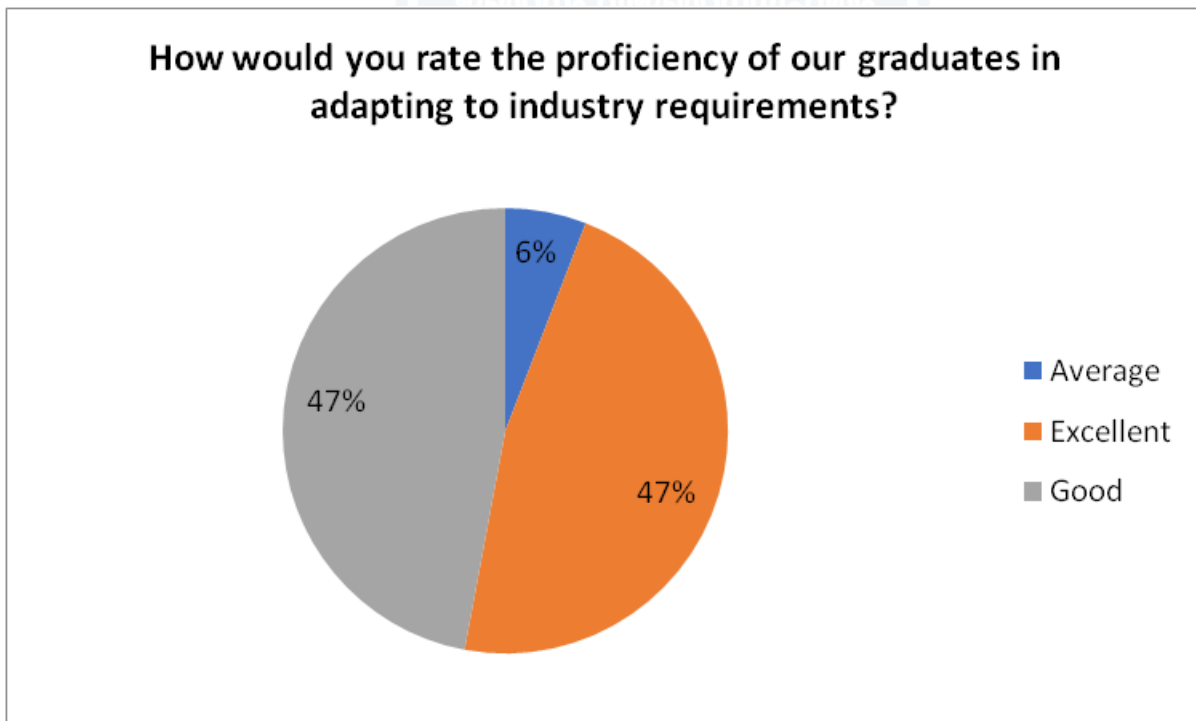

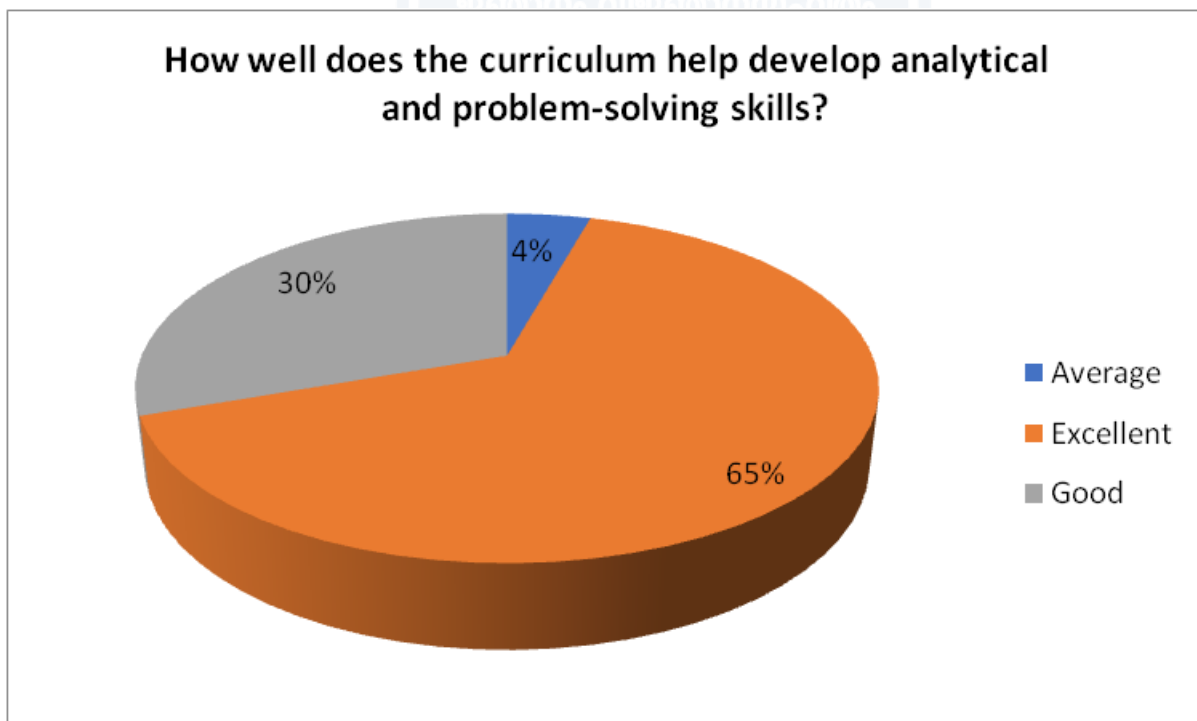

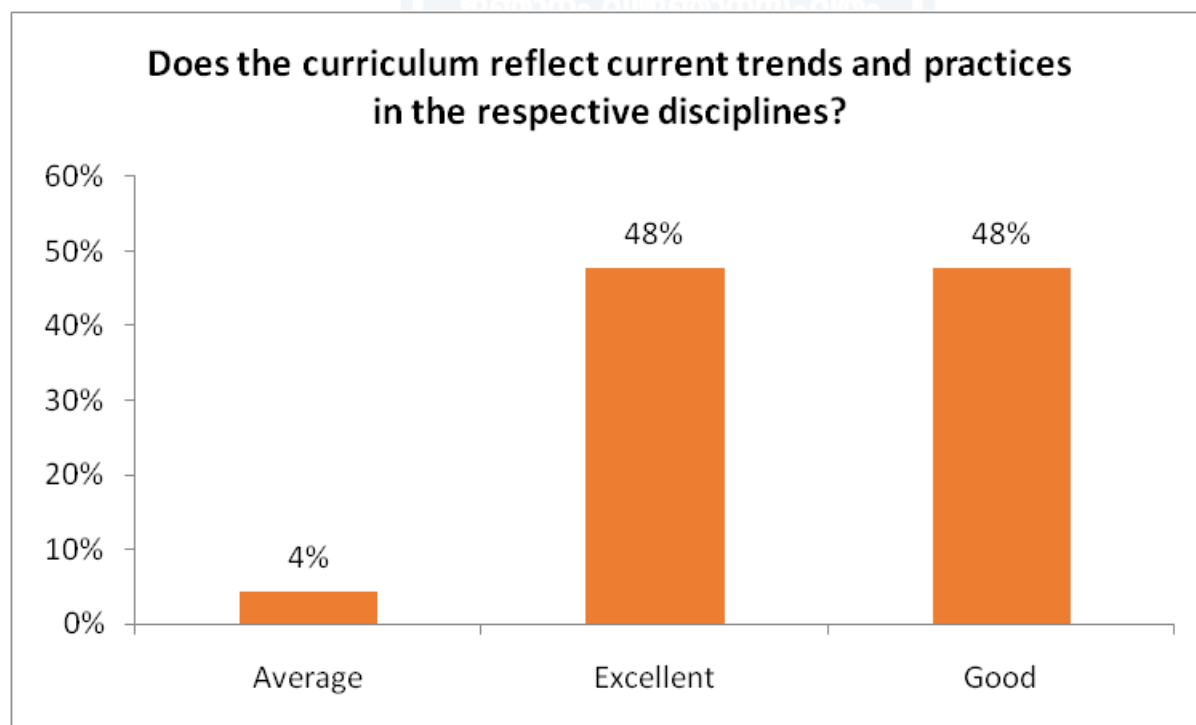
2) How well does the curriculum help develop analytical and problem-solving skills?

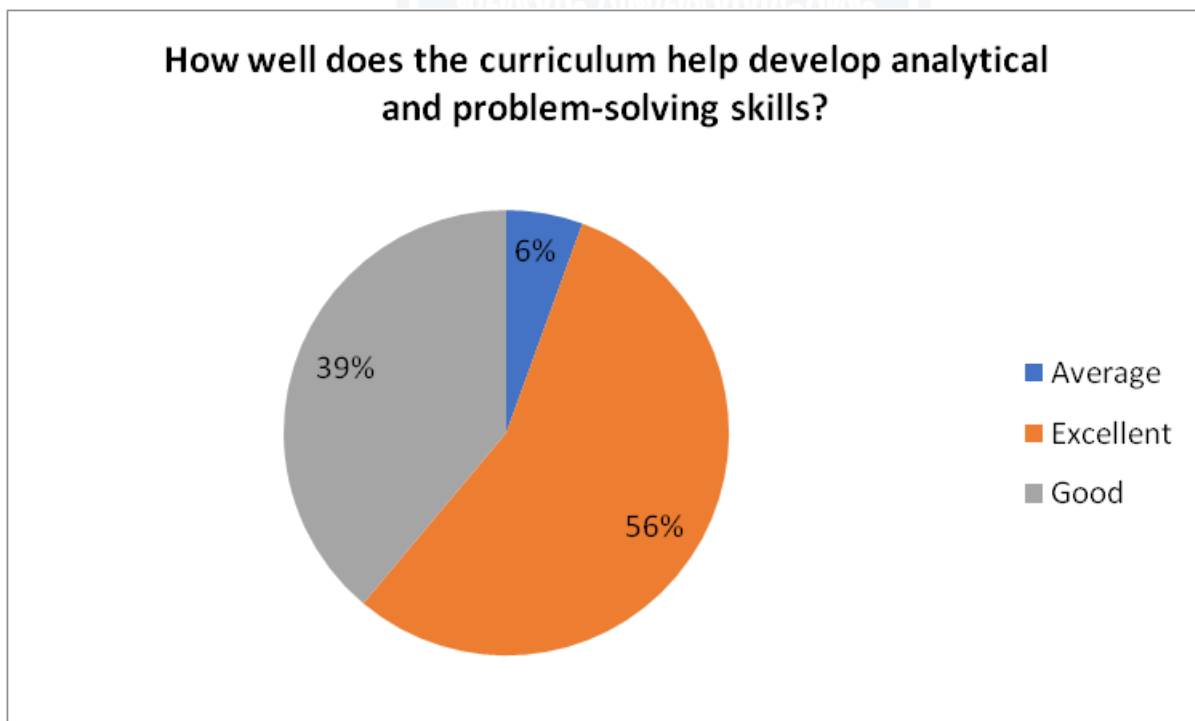

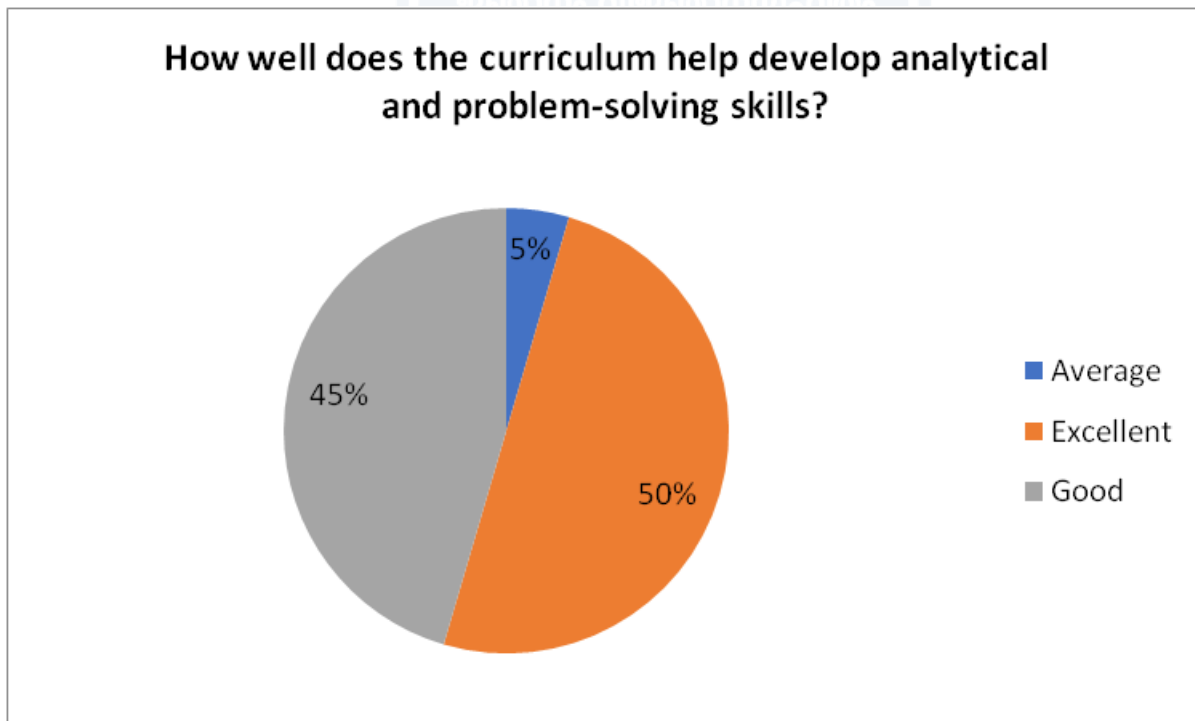

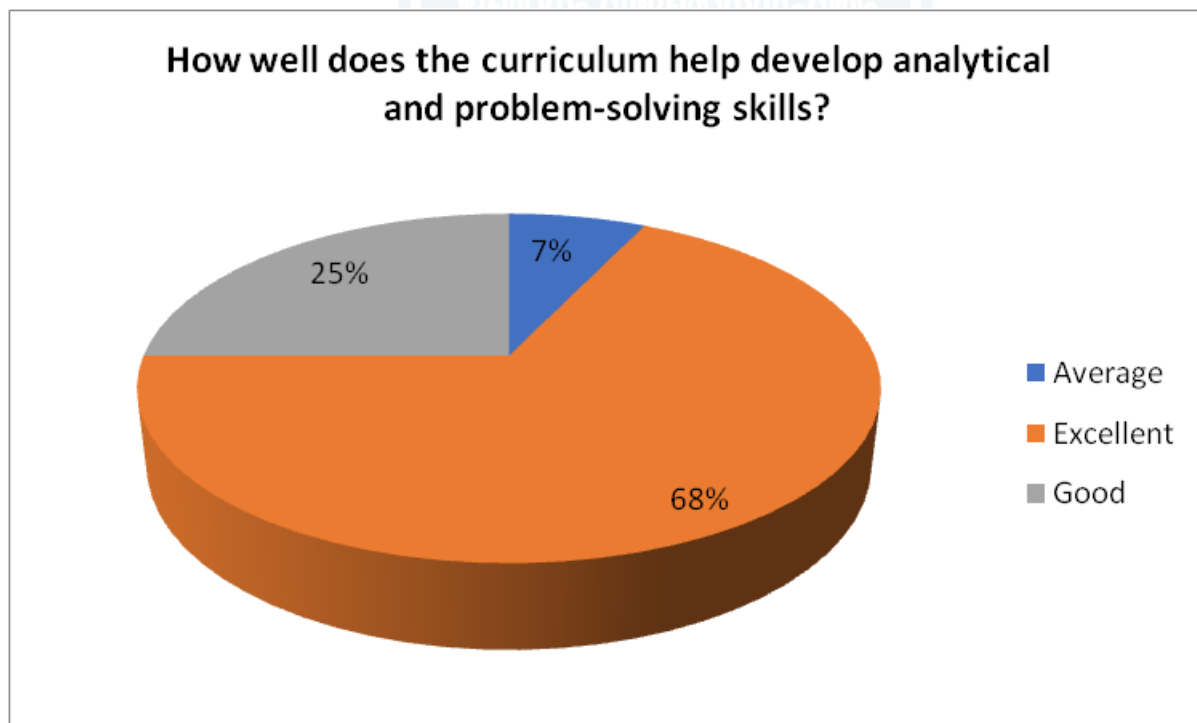

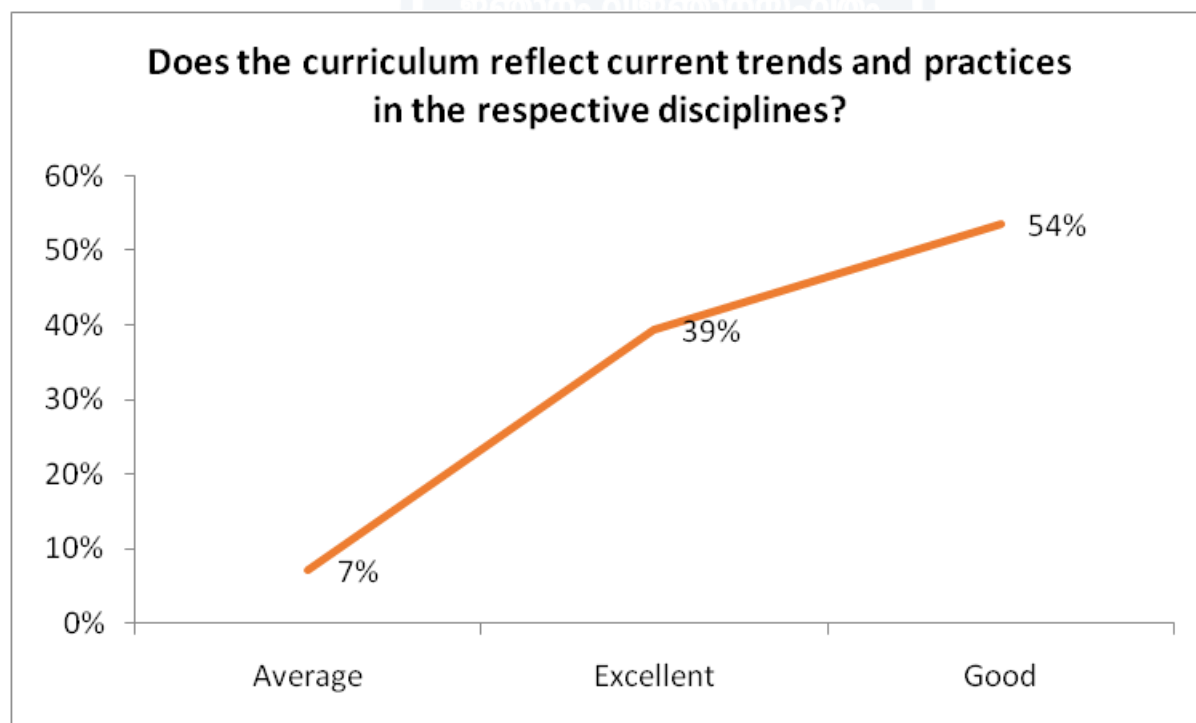
