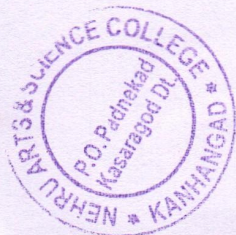

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General Observations

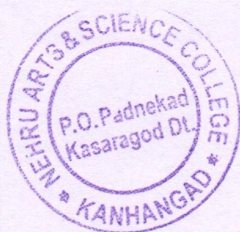
1. The visionary management, coupled with the dedicated faculty and administrative staff, diligently strive to ensure quality across all aspects of this esteemed higher education institution.

4. Each department will prioritize organizing capacity-building programs, particularly focusing on soft skill development and computing skills to empower students for success in diverse

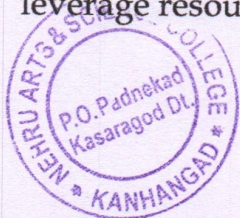


Teaching Learning

Environmental Initiatives

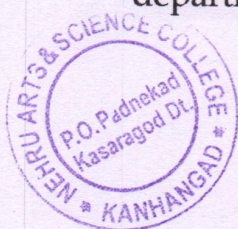
1. Increase the frequency of gender equity programs to promote inclusivity and equality within the college community.

Chemistry

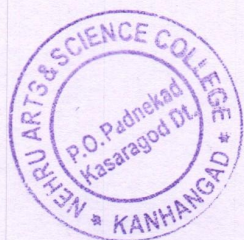
1. Strengthen the departmental Alumni Association to foster a sense of community and support.

History

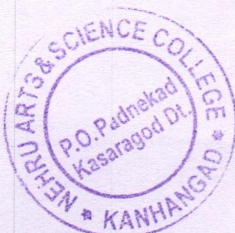

3. Organization of Industrial and Educational Visits:

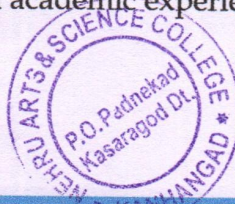
- Departments increased the frequency of industrial and educational visits, ensuring thorough documentation of learning outcomes and experiences.
